See an example of a four week crusade sequence. This sequence was applied for short crusades in the East Caribbean Conference of Seventh-day Adventists.

| Topic | Subject | Objective |
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| First Week | | |
| | Bible | To show that the Bible is the inspired Word of God |
| | Choice and Plan of Salvation | To show the effects of Adam's choice and God's plan to rescue man. |
| | Promise and manner His coming | To prove from the Bible that Jesus will come as promise in power and glory. |
| | Commandments | To highlight that the one who loves Jesus is the one who keeps the 10 commandments, which are still relevant. |
| | Conversion | To show the steps that one takes in becoming a Christian. And what it means to be in Christ. |
| Second Week | | |
| | Sabbath | To prove that Sabbath keeping is Christocentric, showing its connection to creation and redemption |
| | Romance/Family | To deal with issues that affect the family, showing from the Bible what is written down in regards to sex, marriage and divorce. |
| | Baptism | To show that water baptism is a crucial sacrament in the steps to conversion, noting John 3:3-8 |
| | Change of Sabbath | To show from history and the Bible that there has been an attempted change to the day of worship instituted by God |
| | Signs of His coming | Highlight the signs that will precede the second coming of Jesus, noting Matthew 24:14 |
| Week Three | | |
| | Plagues/Judgment | To show what will happen to the man/woman who rejects the salvation Christ offers. Get decisions for baptism. |

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| State of the dead | Using the Bible, refute the doctrine of spiritualism and show what happens to a man when he dies. Get decisions for Baptism. |
| Dangers of Putting off a decision | To show the dangers of putting off a decision to follow Jesus. Get decisions for baptism |
| Excuses | To state and refute any excuse a person uses in preventing that person from following Jesus all the way in baptism. Use stories effectively |
| Courage | To Show that the person who stands up for Christ must be strong and determined. Get decisions for Baptism. |

Week Four

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| The true Church | To show from the Bible that the true church of God will keep the commandments. Expound on the standards and lifestyle of the true church. Get decisions for Baptism |
| Heaven and Hell | Compare and contrast the joys of heaven and the sorrows of hell. Get decisions for Baptism |
| Decision | To show the importance of accepting God when He calls and to help those in the valley of decision to make up their minds to follow Jesus. Get decisions for Baptism. |
| Millennium | To show what will happen when Christ comes again and how the wicked will be destroyed and the earth made new. |
| Holy Spirit | Highlight the work of the Holy Spirit, noting that the unpardonable sin is sinning against the pleadings of the Holy Spirit. |

Note the following:

- Subjects that are not slated in this sequence, must be placed in the question box.
- The First Sabbath Seminar should be held on the Sabbath of the second week. It is recommended that a study be done on the Sabbath.
- The next two Sabbaths should be slated for baptisms. You must preach any subject on decision. For example, Naaman, The Exodus, Jonah, Walls of Jericho, Acts 16:16-34 etc.
